-Vaccine and Booster Eligibility-

Vaccine Eligibility

- You must be at least 6 months old to receive a COVID-19 vaccine
- You can receive the vaccine if you are pregnant and it is recommended.
- You can receive the vaccine if you are immunocompromised and it is recommended. Click this link to learn more recommendations for those immunocompromised:

- You should NOT receive the vaccine if you know you are allergic to any component of the vaccine.
- Children ages 6mo - 5yo can receive the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 and Moderna COVID-19 vaccines.
- Children ages 5yo -11yo can receive the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 and Moderna COVID-19 vaccines.
- Children ages 12yo -17yo can receive the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19, Moderna COVID-19, or Novavax COVID-19 vaccines.

Booster Eligibility

- Children under 5 years old are not yet recommended to receive a booster.
- The CDC recommends that people ages 5 years and older receive one updated (bivalent) booster if it has been at least 2 months since their last COVID-19 vaccine dose.

Mixing Products

- The CDC does not generally recommend mixing products for your primary series vaccine doses. So, for example, if you get Moderna for the first dose in your primary series, you should get Moderna again going forward.
- If you experience an allergic reaction and cannot receive the same product, speak with your doctor to discuss whether it would be safe for you to mix products to complete your vaccination.

-Allergic Reactions-

*Though it is very uncommon, some people have experienced unexpected allergic reactions to doses of the COVID vaccine or booster. So, it is important to know what to do next if you or someone you know experiences an allergic reaction.

Signs of An Allergic Reaction

*You may experience some symptoms that are not listed below. If you think you are having an allergic reaction, call 911. Common symptoms of allergic reactions include...

- Hives

- Rash
- Lip or tongue swelling
- Throat swelling
- Difficulty breathing, wheezing
- Drop in blood pressure

Next Steps

- Though it is not generally recommended to mix COVID vaccine products, after experiencing an allergic reaction from a COVID vaccine, mixing products may be an option for you. Speak to your doctor to discuss what vaccine may be a safe possibility for you to take instead.
- If you need to receive a different product of COVID vaccine following an allergic reaction, you may keep the same COVID vaccination card that you received during your first vaccine dose.
- The Vaccine Adverse Event Reporting System (VAERS) automatically collects reports of allergic reactions from vaccination providers, healthcare professionals, and vaccine manufacturers. So, you do not need to report the allergic reaction yourself.

-Symptoms-

Common Symptoms of COVID-19

*There may be symptoms of COVID that are not listed below. Call your doctor or take a COVID test if you think you may have COVID.

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath, some difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headaches
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

When to Go to the Emergency Room

*Many people contract COVID and do not need emergency intervention. However, there are extreme cases where symptoms become unmanageable and need immediate medical attention. Here are some signs that you should either call 911 or have someone drive you to the ER (Emergency Room).

- Significant difficulty breathing
- Confusion or disorientation
- Lips or hands that start to look pale, blue-ish, or gray-ish (discoloration)
- Inability to stay awake or wake up
- Intense chest pain
- Feeling lightheaded

-What To Do As A Close Contact-

Definition of a “Close Contact”

*You are generally considered to be a close contact if you...

- Live with someone who has COVID
- Have spent more than 4 hours with someone in a closed environment (such as a household or elderly care center) since they developed COVID
- Spent more than 15 minutes with someone infected with COVID at a distance of less than 6 feet away

Next Steps If You Are A Close Contact

- QUARANTINE: If you are a carrier of COVID, this means that you can pass the virus onto others. Quarantining will help reduce the amount of people that you transmit COVID to. While

- **GET TESTED:** If you suspect that you have contracted COVID, the best way to be sure is to get tested. Even if you do not have symptoms, if you know you are a close contact, it is important to get tested as soon as possible because symptoms may develop later. Some people are also asymptomatic and do not have any symptoms but are still infected with COVID. Asymptomatic people can still spread COVID to others who may experience symptoms.
- **WEAR A MASK:** If you cannot avoid going out in public for certain tasks like getting food, or if you live with others in your household, wearing a mask can help stop the spread of COVID to those you come into contact with (who are not already infected). -Treatment Options At Home-

*A majority of COVID-19 cases can be treated at home and do not require professional medical attention at a hospital. Here are some recommendations from Mayo Clinic for at-home treatment options if you are experiencing a mild case of COVID-19.

- **REST:** Rest as much as possible. If you have COVID you should not be going to work and should avoid going out in public as much as possible. Limit activity in the home as much as you can to help your body rest and recover.
- **FLUIDS:** A steady intake of fluids will help keep your body hydrated. This is especially important if you are experiencing symptoms like diarrhea that can dehydrate the body quickly. Fluids could include water, tea, fresh juices, broths, or electrolyte solutions like Gatorade or Powerade.
- **PAIN RELIEVERS:** Pain relievers can help with symptom management if you are experiencing body aches, headaches, a fever or a sore throat. Common pain relievers that are sold over-the-counter (without a prescription from a doctor) include medications like Tylenol, Motrin, or Advil. Make sure to read the instructions and recommendations for whichever pain reliever you purchase to see if it is a safe medication for you to take.
